forevermore. | Amen.

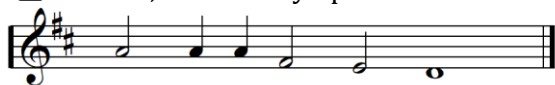

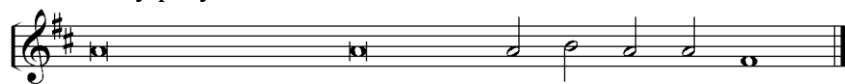
